

NADD survey, class sizes, 2/4/2016

Nineteen programs responded to questions about class size, fourteen public and five private. One private university did not have a BSW.

Several schools have pre-social work or introductory courses. These range in size from 25 to 120 students. The largest class did not have a GTA. It did have an experienced faculty member. I have grouped responses into categories since most respondents reported a range. Six public programs and one private program said they did not have GTAs for undergrad programs.
